American Airlines "Take Flight to Your Future" **Aviation Career Development program**

In partnership with American Airlines, Flight Academy has created a new year long career development initiative designed to exposed underserved students to the broad array of careers in the aviation industry. This one-of-a-kind program includes monthly student visits to the Flight Academy, onsite visits by Patriots Point staff at partner schools, and

standards based materials and digital interface. Last year, 20 Military Magnet Academy students took part in this program, and this academic year, 50 MMA students chose to enroll. The program will be expanding to other Title 1 schools, and all costs for students are covered by the USS Yorktown Foundation.
